

Resolution 2: To Encourage Faithful Practice of Member Churches in Matters of Church Fellowship

XXII World Conference of the International Lutheran Council

Whereas there is agreement amongst all ILC members that unity of doctrine and practice is the

only basis for Church Fellowship; and

Whereas there are differences in detailed applications of Church Fellowship in pastoral situations

and in different historical and cultural contexts; and

Whereas some churches of the ILC, while holding broadly to a common understanding of the basis

for Church Fellowship namely agreement in doctrine and practice, participate in the LWF for reasons that are unique to their situations and in such a way as not to deny the basis

for confessional fellowship;

therefore be it

Resolved: that in respecting the autonomy of churches, the ILC holds it to be the responsibility of

each member church to act in matters of Church Fellowship according to its conscience

on the basis of the revealed Word of God, and our confessions; and be it finally

Resolved: that the ILC and all its members encourage one another in the faithful expressions of

unity of doctrine and practice, and to accept such fraternal encouragement from one

another.
